ARABIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS VICTORIA

General Rules and Conditions

1. The Victorian Arabian Championships is conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations for the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd. Competitors are responsible for becoming familiar with all sections of these rules as they form a part of the conditions of Entry for this show. Copies of the rules can be obtained through the AHSA Ltd or downloaded from http://www.ahsa.asn.au/show_rule_book.htm Registrations pending will be accepted and catalogued. It is up to the **owner** to prove to the show committee that the horse is registered prior to the class. In the event that no proof is forthcoming the exhibit will be scratched and entry fees will be forfeited.

Conditions of Entry

2. The show committee shall have the power without assigning any reasons to:
 - Reject or cancel any entry at any time.
 - Cancel any event or class.
 - Order the removal of any exhibitor from the showgrounds.
 - Transfer an exhibit or exhibitor from any class to any other class.
 - Change the running order of classes in the event of obvious clashes

If there are insufficient/sufficient numbers, classes may be combined or divided at the discretion of the ACV Committee.

Junior exhibitors to be 17 years and under.

Stallions and colts must be handled and ridden by persons 18 years and over.

All riders under 18 years must wear an Australian Safety Approved Riding Helmet; this rule also applies to the costume class.

All ridden horses must be 3 years and over.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the horse is unable to compete.

Any horse or pony that causes interference to another exhibit may be asked to retire from the event.

Exhibitors will be notified by mail approximately 10 days prior to the show. Advise will be given regarding stable allocation and starting times.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - General Rules and Conditions (cont).

TATURA EXHIBITION AND EVENTS COMPLEX

NO SMOKING IS PERMITTED IN THE INDOOR ARENA COMPLEX, STABLES AND CATTLE PAVILIONS.

This will be strictly enforced.

NO GLASS ALLOWED in Indoor Arena Complex.

No straw or hay allowed in Indoor Arena Complex.

All emergency exits must be kept free from obstructions.

Access to all fire hose reels and extinguishers must be maintained at all times.

No camping is permitted within these areas.

Camping is permitted only in approved areas and campsite fees are compulsory.

All electrical equipment, appliances or leads used by anyone entering the site (including exhibitors, carpenters, trade displays etc.) must bear a current appliance test tag as affixed by a qualified electrician before they can be used on site. **This is a requirement of Victorian Government Legislation** and will be enforced other venues/sites.

Transport vehicles must not be parked on site in a position which blocks access to any of the facilities, especially for emergency vehicles. It is recommended vehicles are parked in a designated area and around the perimeter of the facility and as directed by parking officials.

Maintain a 10 metre clear access to all fire hydrants on site.

Straw and sawdust is permitted to be used as stable bedding.

Whip length: In ridden classes hacking canes or riding crops should not exceed 75cms (2 feet 6 inches). Normal length dressage whips are acceptable in most classes. For In-Hand classes length of whip is not to exceed 100cms (3.6 feet) including handle & tail. Any inappropriate action which could be deemed indiscriminate or excessive will result in the handler or rider being asked to leave the ring. Whip marks will not be accepted.

Protests and Appeals

A Protests and Appeals Committee will be appointed prior to the show. All protests must be made in writing and a fee of \$55.00 must accompany each protest. This fee will be refunded unless the protest is deemed frivolous. Protests must be lodged within the hour of the class or event taking place.

Committee Accepts No Responsibility

It is the policy of the Committee to see all due care is taken to protect property, but the Committee shall not be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of defect, accident, negligence, however arising.

Amateur Owner Classes

An Amateur is one who regardless of his/her equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, does not act as a professional and has been issued with a current Amateur Card by the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited.
