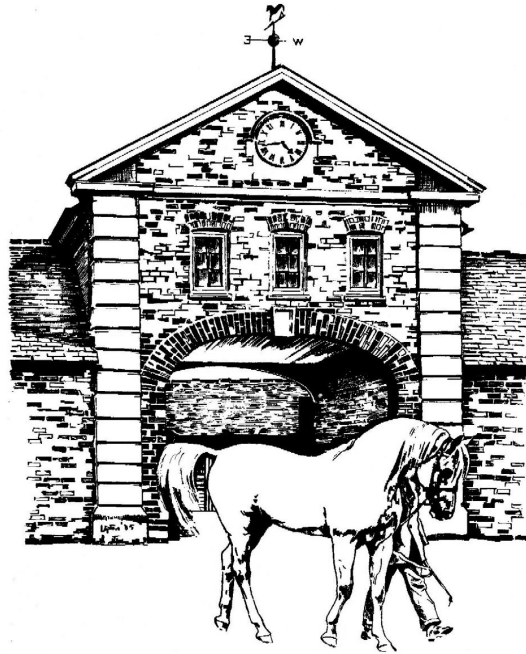

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Pure Crabbet Horses = Horses of 100% Crabbet breeding/bloodlines only. \*Crabbet is defined as \*Descended from pure Arabian horses purchases, owned or bred by Wilfred Blunt, Lady Anne Blunt, Lady Wentworth or Crabbet Park\* **An extended pedigree should be submitted for all Crabbet horses who have not been entered in Crabbet classes in previous years. Entries on the day not accepted.**
2. **PURE Crabbet** both led and ridden classes are **FREE ONLY** if the exhibit is entered in the open led and ridden classes
3. All horses must be registered with A.H.S.A Ltd. Proof of registration must be available on request. **Photocopy of both sides of registration to accompany entries or entries will not be accepted.**
4. Birth date of all horses to be taken from 1<sup>st</sup> of August. All ridden horses must be 3 years and over.
5. Stallions and colts must be handled or ridden by a person 18 years and over.
6. Geldings shown in gelding classes must have been gelded. Colts registered as geldings cannot compete in colt classes.
7. Geldings are only eligible for Supreme Gelding Award. Geldings therefore are not permitted to compete for other Supreme led classes.
8. Veteran horses may compete in other led classes in their age group.
9. The judge's decision in all cases is final. Verbal or physical abuse to Judges, Officials, Committee Members, Stewards will result in instant disqualification of all Exhibit/s entered by the exhibitor or handler. Horses displaying any whip marks or sign of abuse will not be judged.
10. Entry fees will not be refunded without a medical or vet certificate.
11. All bridles and show halters must have a throat latch.
12. Broodmares must have a foal at foot or be visibly in foal in the current season. A vet certificate must accompany Mares in foal with entries. Foals should be 6 weeks or older at the time of show.
13. All riders must wear an Australian Safety approved riding helmet at all times whilst on a horse with the National equestrian centre.
14. No responsibility will be taken for any damage, loss or accident that may be caused or suffered by any exhibit or person, and it is a condition of entry that everyone shall hold the organizers indemnified against any claim in respect of any accident, loss or damage
15. All horses must be branded except foals at foot
16. Whip Length for ridden 75cm and halter is 110cm including handle and tail
17. Exhibits are not to be excessively stirred up, horses must remain calm in the marshalling area with the maximum of one handler and one groom. No devices artificial gadgets or loud noises shall be used to excite horses. This rule also applies to other person outside of the marshalling area and the show ring. Exhibits that are excessively excited may be asked to leave the show ring or the marshalling area if they are disturbing or upsetting other horses. Handlers are not to excite stallions to challenge each other by facing them up to each other or crowding them. The facing of stallions is strictly prohibited
18. The card system will be in place 3 yellow cards (warnings) you will receive a red card and anyone receiving a red card in the ring or marshalling area will not be able to compete for the remainder of the day. All yellow and red cards will be reported to AHSA
19. The show organizers shall have the power to cancel, divide or combine classes remove any exhibit from the ground or reject or cancel any entry at any time.
20. **Novice** under saddle means not to have placed 1st at any "A" class show under saddle and must be ridden in a snaffle bit, no spurs are allowed. **Elementary** under saddle means not to have won a championship under saddle at any open event.
21. **Newcomer** under saddle is defined as a horse that has not competed under saddle prior to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2007. The exhibit must be ridden in a snaffle, whips and spurs are not permitted.
22. **Liberty** whips and shakers only to be used and be used in moderation, No other items are to be taken into the ring Approx 2 minute workout required, 1 min catching time is allowed. The horse should show no sign of stress.
23. **Amateur owner/handler** horses entered must be registered in the handlers' name. An amateur card is to be presented upon entry Please see AHSA rules
24. **Improver classes** These classes are to encourage Amateurs that do not have an official AHSA Amateur card Amateur rules do still apply Handlers are to not to be a judge professional handler or accepts any remuneration in equitation or horse training
25. Stallion tender foal must be from the 2007 stallion tender free entry approved by the VCAHG inc
26. All exhibits must have a number either on the horse or handler/rider before entering the ring
27. All exhibit numbers must be returned to the secretaries' office. A \$5 deposit will be charged for all numbers and refunded upon their return in good condition
28. Where conflict arises between VCAHG Inc rules and AHSA standard show rules, VCAHG Inc rules apply
29. Dogs are permitted but must be on a leash and are not permitted near the entry of the rings
30. Ensure you are aware of the National Equestrian Centre Rules and Regulations and abide by them at all times

- All Crabbet classes are 'B' rated for the Australian Arabian Roll Of Merit
- All Open Purebred, all Ridden and Derivative classes 'A' rated for the Australian Arabian Roll Of Merit
- Entires close 15<sup>th</sup> October 2007. Late entries will be accepted on the day at **\$30.00 per class and \$15 thereafter.**
